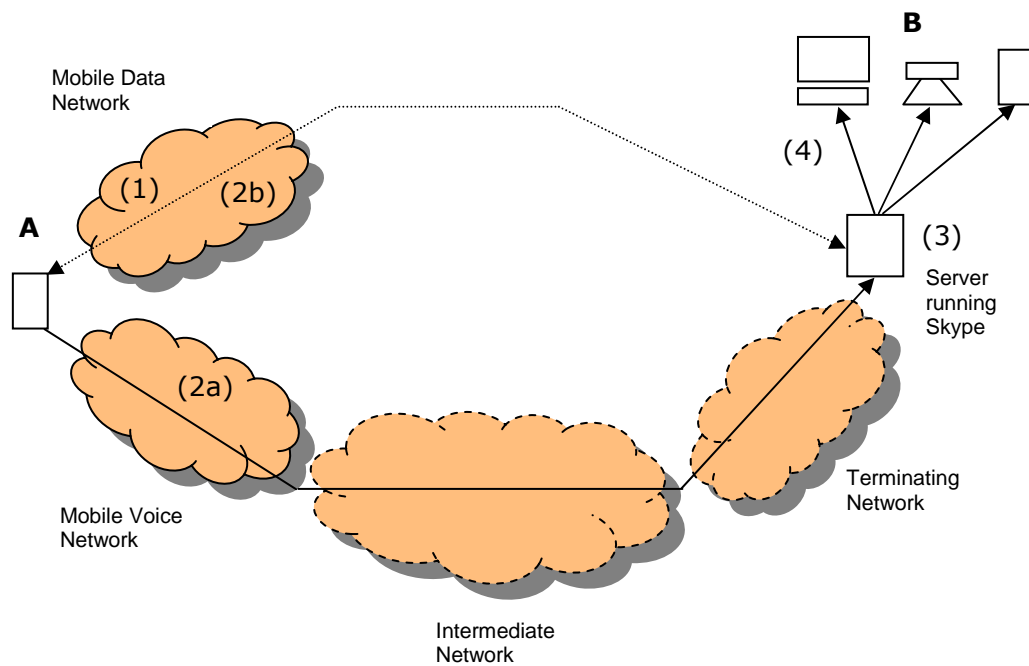


Tutorial: Call-Through System - Mobile Access to Skype



(1) Caller A logs in to the application on his mobile phone using his Skype ID and password and the application retrieves his buddy list over the mobile's data channel.

(2a) Caller A selects the contact B he wants to call and the application makes a regular voice call to a gateway server and signals who A wants to call over the data channel (2b).

(3) The server instantiates a Skype client with A's credentials.

(4) The Skype client makes a Skype (or SkypeOut) call to the contact B and conferences it with A's call to the gateway server so A and B can talk together.

If the Mobile Access to Skype/IM Talk service is provided by A's mobile service provider the call to the gateway does not have to traverse an Intermediate or Terminating network
